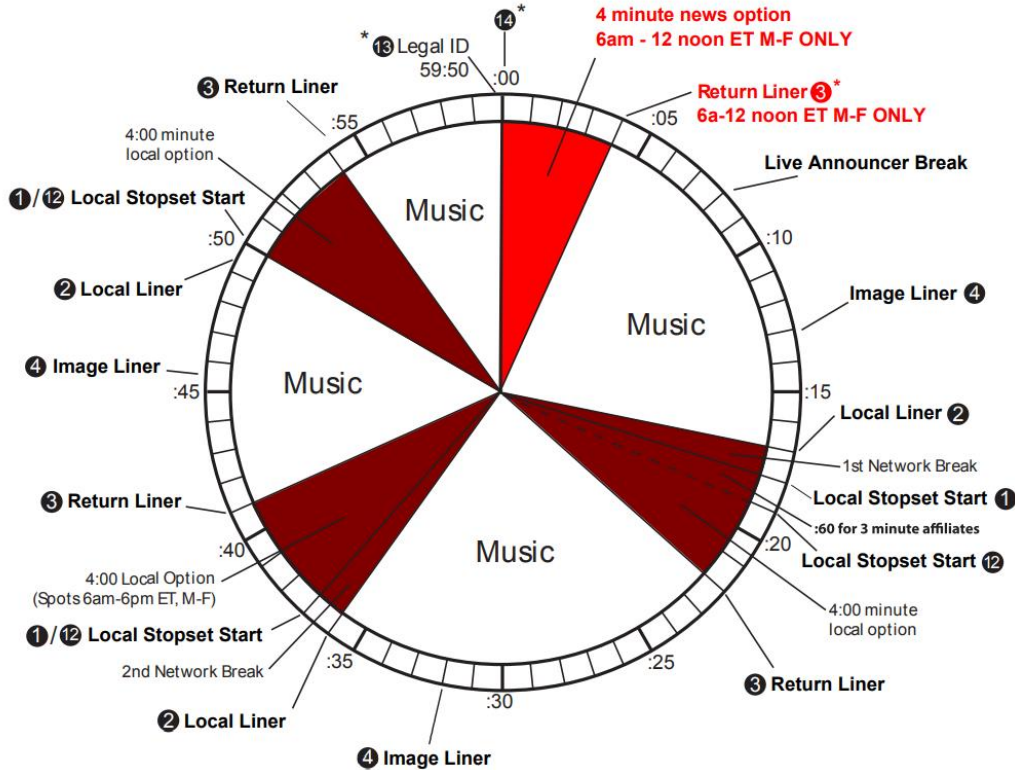

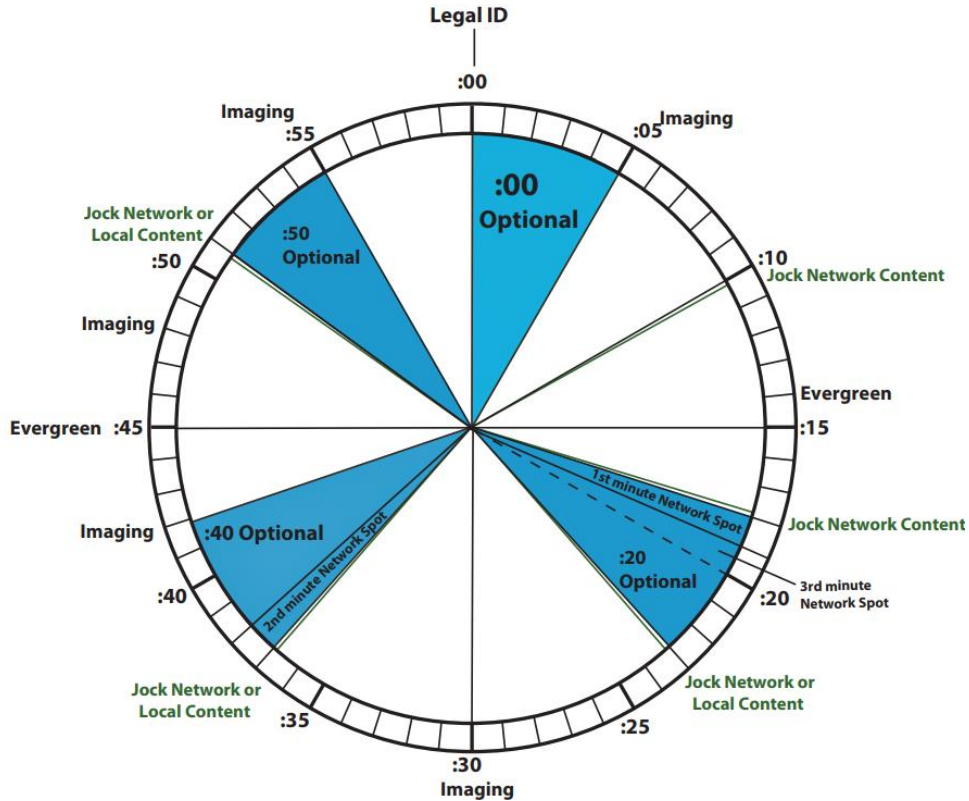

(1a-6a eastern)

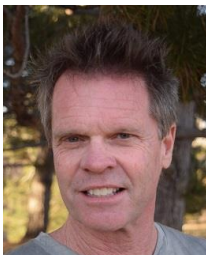

(6a-10a eastern)

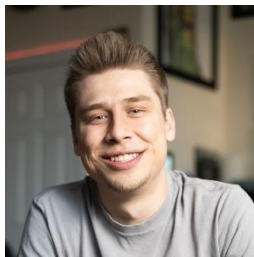
